Fact Fragments

Use the question for your global warming specialty area and your keyword diagram to scan the article for information that answers the question.

Use the techniques we practice in class:

- Scan headings, subheadings, captions, and first sentences.
- When you've found a section that you like, circle it.
- Look at the first sentence in each paragraph of that section. Does it relate to your question? If not, X out that paragraph.
- If the paragraph looks good, read each sentence, one at a time. Does the sentence help answer your question? If not, cross it out.
- Look at each word in a good sentence. Does the word help answer your question? If not cross it out.
- When you have finished the section, circle all of the words that help answer your question and write them on your data sheet.

When you have completed one section, turn the article over. Using ONLY the words on your data sheet, paraphrase what you learned from the article. Use the back of this paper.

You should complete at least one section of the article that you think answers your question. You can do more for extra practice.
