Journal Checklist

Your journal should include:

- Many facts you find in the online resources
 - o Facts about daily life
 - Facts about colonization (for example: why did the colonists come, how did the Wampanoags react when they arrived, how did the two groups get along?)
- Your reactions to what you learn
 - Is it different from what you had heard before? If so, how does that make you feel?
 - o Does it support what you already knew?
 - o Does it raise new questions?
 - Have you ever had any experiences that make you sympathize with your group?
- Comparison/contrast of the different sources
 - o Do the sources always agree on the facts?
 - o If not, how are they different?
 - Which do you think is most likely to be accurate? Why?
- Hard Thinking
 - o Do you think there is such a thing as a "true" history?
 - o How can we get closer to a true history?

There may not be a "right answer." I want to read about your opinions and your struggles with these hard questions. A copy of the rubric that will be used to grade your journal is on the Evaluation page of the WebQuest.
